**ALL'** Our Building Committee, with help and advice from the Diocese, recently applied to The Big Lottery 'Awards for All' Scheme. We sought funding to undertake a professional feasibility study of the needs of the local community, and how we could be equipped to meet them. On the Monday before Christmas we received a letter from 'Awards for All' confirming that we would be receiving a grant of £9,400 for this purpose. This will help to inform our decisions about developing our parish and site.

**KNOTWEED REMOVED** The knotweed in a part of the former allotment behind the church has been removed. In tracing it, the contractors excavated at the deepest point to about 2 ½ meters. In all, around 30 square meters of soil was processed. The largest roots were about 1 ½ inches thick, breakable by hand, and showing an orange interior, which greatly helps to identify them. The cost, with a 10 year guarantee, is £12,000, plus VAT-£14,400, which we will now have to raise.
