1,000 YEARS SINCE ST OSBURG Osburg was a Benedictine Abbess, sent from the North of England by King Canute at the beginning of the 11th Century to found a monastery in the Midlands. She chose a spot by what is now known as the River Sherbourne. This was the first settlement and developed into what is now Coventry. It was the 4th most prominent City in England in the Middle Ages. There was a strong cult to St Osburg in the City at that time, her Feast Day being a public holiday. The Catholic Community in Coventry are marking the 1,000th anniversary of the death of St Osburg. Archbishop Bernard will be the Main Celebrant at Mass at St Osburg's Church on Sunday 11th Sept, which Church Leaders and Civic Dignitaries will also be attending. I have been invited, having served for 16 years as Parish Priest. Fr Zbigniew Zieba, who is Professor of Scripture at Oscott College, has accepted to supply here that morning. When he came from Poland and first served in this country the people found his name difficult to pronounce and, instead, called him Fr Ziggy, which has stuck. Fr Ziggy assisted me for several years at St Osburg's while he worked on his Doctorate.
