Typical of the situations we dealt with is an adopted woman in her sixties, for whom we found her sisters and put them in touch. In another situation, we put a birth mother in touch with the son she parted with for adoption over 30 years previously. He was touched that she asked for him to be contacted and she in turn was delighted his adoption had turned out so well. So thank you for supporting us in this work."
