parishes are informed of the amount of levy each will pay in 2018. Two thirds of the levy goes to the Diocesan Education Service and one third to the Curial expenses. Each parish is required to pay 28.4% of the previous year's total offertories. Our total offertories for 2016 amounted to £22,606.20. So, our levy this year is £6,430.71, taken quarterly. Our offertories work out at £434.73 per week; our levy £123.65 per week. This leaves £311 a week to pay for the heating, lighting, insurance on the church and house; council tax, Father's salary, housekeeping, car mileage, printing, supply priests etc. Each parish is self-reliant, hence the importance of each person's regular contribution, which is greatly appreciated.
