received a letter from 'Awards for All' confirming that we would be receiving a grant of £9,400 for this purpose. This will help to inform our decisions about developing our parish and site.

KNOTWEED REMOVED

The knotweed in a part of the former allotment behind the church was removed during the week. In tracing it, the contractors excavated at the deepest point to about 2½ meters. In all, around 30 square meters of soil was processed. The largest roots were about 1½ inches thick, breakable by hand, and showing an orange interior, which greatly helps to identify them. The cost, with a 10 year guarantee, is £12,000, plus VAT- £14,400, which we will now have to raise.
