PARISH CONSULTATION On Wednesday evening 25 members of the parish met at the Parish Council Room, Bidford School. I outlined the development of the parish to date, especially the vision and generosity of our forebears in buying the builder's workshop and this site 57 years ago, and later the house as a presbytery. On 14th June last year we met as a parish to discuss our mission and various aspects of it. One of the committees formed was the Building Committee. Andy Jinks, as Chair, said that in time, it was likely there would be only one weekend Mass and the church needed to be able to accommodate everyone. He then outlined the work that the committee has done; the meetings with property, legal and fundraising representatives of the diocese; and the grant to undertake a professional feasibility study.

Andy then introduced Naomi Fisher, a Director of APEC Architects of Birmingham whom we appointed to undertake the study. She led us in a table exercise to consider what facilities would enhance our mission and how they could be configured in practice. A vital part of the consultation is a Questionnaire for each of us to express our thoughts about this. There are copies on the seats in church. The
