-The inmates from Long Lartin Prison suggest a present for their child and write a personal Christmas wish as a label to their child.

-Volunteers buy an appropriate gift approx. £12-£15 to include postage. The charity reimburses the volunteer.

- The presents are wrapped, labelled and posted to the children to open on Christmas day.

- The inmates receive a card from Angel Tree informing them which present his child will receive on Christmas morning.

For the last few years, St. Joseph's has helped the Angel tree Charity. Last year approx.. 90 presents went out to children. St Joseph's group bought about a third of these
