BORN IN CARE, NOW A DAME As part of Father Hudson's celebration of Black History Month, they invited supporters to a talk by Dame Elizabeth Anionwu. This was their introduction: "Dame Elizabeth, of Irish Nigerian heritage was born in our Mother & Baby Home, then was in our care until she was eight years old, placed initially in our nursery on the Coleshill campus and then placed

by us at Nazareth House in Rednal. Dame Elizabeth went on to become Emeritus Professor of Nursing at University of West London, has an honorary doctorate from Birmingham University, was made a Dame in 2017, got a Lifetime Achievement Award in the 2019 Pride of Britain Awards for her achievements in nursing. In 2020, BBC named her in 100 Women of the Year, in their list of inspiring and influential women from around the world. For the NHS's 70th anniversary she was named as one of the 70 most influential nurses in its history. She revised and republished her book in Sept. 2021, now called "Dreams From My Mother."
